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Follow UK On 'Trans' Problem

Australia should follow the UK and hold an inquiry into the treatment of gender-confused children, according to advocacy group FamilyVoice Australia.

FamilyVoice has welcomed a move by <u>UK Secretary of State for Health and Social Care Sajid Javid to scrutinise the radical gender treatment of minors</u> in a situation that is failing children.

It has been reported that the health secretary believes vulnerable children are wrongly prescribed gender hormone treatments and has compared the discussion of the topic to the fear of racism when investigating grooming gangs in Rotherham.

"In 2019, more than 200 doctors called for Health Minister Greg Hunt to hold an urgent inquiry into the risky medical treatment of children who are gender-confused, but Health Minister Greg Hunt refused to hold an inquiry," said FamilyVoice spokesman David d'Lima.

"Greg Hunt's decision to quit politics presents an opportunity for the Coalition to revisit his decision not to hold an inquiry.

"An inquiry is needed as a matter of priority. The longer the delay, the more harm that will be done to children."

FamilyVoice notes the increase in opposition to trans ideology.

<u>"A Melbourne psychiatrist has warned</u> about the mutilation of girls who identify as boys as an experiment that future generations may judge harshly," David d'Lima said.

"An Australian inquiry should hear evidence from the prominent UK detransitioner Keira Bell, who has slammed the prescribing of puberty-blocking drugs to children under 18."
