## **One In Four Australians Forced To Hide Their Views**

Christian advocacy group FamilyVoice Australia is urging schools to ensure they give opportunity for diverse expression, instead of operating as "politically-correct bubble zones" that stifle expression.

The call comes amid <u>a new report which shows that almost one in four Australians have</u> been forced to hide their views on social issues and politics as a result of cancel culture.

"Parents must rise up to insist our schools stop functioning as politically-correct bubble zones that do not allow respectful, free and diverse expression," said FamilyVoice spokesman David d'Lima.

"Mums and dads must not standby when nearly half of our young people are struggling to express their views without fear of recriminations.

"Schools should be places of free education, and teachers serve in the place of parents who cannot possibly be pleased to learn that their children cannot express themselves," he said.
