Kyam Maher Warned Against Rush On Kill Bill

Advocacy group FamilyVoice Australia is warning Attorney-General Kyam Maher not to fast-track euthanasia laws.

Maher has said that he is "keen to see if there is any way that this can be implemented more quickly".

But FamilyVoice spokesman David d'Lima warned against such a move.

"Euthanasia laws place the elderly and the frail at risk. Any move to shortcut what is already a flawed process will inevitably put more lives on the line.

"The priority of the Government at this time should be supporting the health system, including addressing the ramping crisis, not ending patients' lives.

"The Malinauskas Government in its early days would do well to stick to its election commitments rather than risk being known as taking a cynical approach to the lives of South Australians," said d'Lima.
