Sanctity of Life	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ No explicit policy to support extreme abortion laws ★ Abortion is a conscience vote ★ Euthanasia is a conscience vote 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Supports extreme abortion laws allowing killing of preborn babies up to birth ★ Passed euthanasia laws
Religious Freedom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Supports returning rights of faith-based organisations in ethos-based hiring, but party leader opposes extending it to terminating staff who practise an ethos that is inconsistent with the school's values 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Passed laws restricting the ability of faith-based organisations to operate according to their ethos
Freedom to seek therapy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Will maintain laws that criminalise evidence-based therapy, counselling or prayer for people who are confused about their sexuality or gender 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Passed law that criminalises patient-led, evidence-based therapy, counselling or prayer for those who want help with unwanted sexual attraction or gender dysphoria
Gender ideology upon minors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ No policy on Education Department policy allowing teachers to hide a child's gender transition from parents ★ No policy to oppose extreme gender ideology curriculum, from kindergarten to year 12 ★ No policy to remove 'X' gender on birth certificates 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Launched Education Department policy allowing teachers to hide a child's gender transition from parents ★ Created & mandated extreme gender & sexuality ideology curriculum, from kindergarten to year 12, teaching fluid gender and sexuality theories ★ Added 'X' gender on birth certificates
Freedom of Speech	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ No policy to amend anti-vilification laws that ban "causing offence" on basis of religious beliefs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Passed anti-religion vilification laws & supports "in principle" expanding civil and criminal restrictions, and thus silence debate on gender identity, sexuality, and personal association
