"Transgender" Operations	★ No policy to force taxpayers to publicly fund "sex-change" operations	★ Will require taxpayers to publicly fund "sex-change" operations
Radical Gender Ideology in Schools	★ Cut funding to radical gender ideology 'Safe Schools' program	★ Supports funding for radical gender ideology in schools
National Chaplaincy program	★ Introduced and continues to support holistic, spritual-focused Chaplaincy program	★ Abolished chaplaincy program and replaced it with watered-down secularised, psychological program
Faith-based Schools	<ul> <li>★ Support the right of faith-based schools to hire staff of their choice</li> <li>★ Oppose faith schools determining student enrolment policies</li> </ul>	★ Wants to restrict faith-based schools and hospitals when hiring staff, and to restrict enrolment policies in faith-based schools
Freedom of Religious Organisations	★ Support right of faith-based organisations to hire staff of their choice	★ Will further restrict faith-based organisations (e.g. hospitals) to operate according to their values
Freedom of Speech	★ Voted through laws restricting free speech concerning discussions about sexuality and gender	★ Introduced and passed laws restricting free speech concerning discussions about sexuality and gender
