PM Needs To Take Stronger Stand On Trans Ideology

Christian advocacy group FamilyVoice Australia is urging Prime Minister Scott Morrison to bring the Coalition into supporting Warringah candidate Katherine Deves, as she seeks a fair go for female athletes.

FamilyVoice spokesman David d'Lima said the PM made a "captain's pick" in the preselection of Katherine Deves and "she must not take all the pressure for sensibly defending the rights of women."

Ms Deves has been forced from their Sydney home, following death threats and intimidation.

FamilyVoice urges the PM to insist the Coalition makes it a policy of government to defend the freedom of women to enjoy sports without biological males in the competition.

"Australian women need an election commitment to protect female sports," he said.

"Fairness in sports is a huge opportunity for the Prime Minister to assert common sense ahead of the election."

"He should also cancel taxpayer-funding to sporting groups that compel girls and women to compete against gender-confused males.

"Taxpayers should not be forced to fund injustice. Girls and women deserve a fair go in sport."
