Reduced spend on IBAC concerning

The Andrews government's decision to give IBAC \$700K less in funding than it spent last financial year is concerning, according to FamilyVoice Australia.

"The Andrews' government has kept IBAC very busy so it's interesting to see that it has been allocated less money than it spent in the previous financial year", said FamilyVoice spokesman Alan Barron.
