Cut ABC funding

A crash in ratings at the ABC justifies a budget cut, according to FamilyVoice Australia.

The ABC's flagship radio program has continued to plummet in the ratings, averaging as low as just 1000 listeners in one capital city.

"People are turning off the ABC due to its toxic left-wing politics", said FamilyVoice spokesman David d'Lima.

"The ABC's coverage of King Charles' coronation, like so much of the ABC's other content, was disgraceful.

"It's no wonder people are turning off in droves.

"So the question then is why taxpayers should be forced to fund it to the tune of a billion dollars.
