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Castle Law Queensland's Largest E-Petition Ever

FamilyVoice Australia today is calling on the Queensland David Crisafulli Government to listen to the clear public mandate shown by **over 109,000 Queenslanders** who have signed the Castle Law petition.

History has been made today; **Queensland has a new record e-petition!** That record calls for Castle Law – legislation that would allow residents the right to protect their families and homes from invasion and violence.

“Queenslanders have spoken with one voice: **your home should be the safest place in the world,**” said **Andrew McColl**, Queensland Director of FamilyVoice Australia. “More than 109,936 citizens want Parliament to provide clear, common-sense protections for families who face home invasion. If the government is serious about reducing crime and protecting Queenslanders they must act.”

“This is not about vigilante justice,” Andrew McColl said. “It’s about **legal clarity** for mums, dads and grandparents who never asked for trouble, and **fairness** for victims who act in fear to protect their loved ones.”

FamilyVoice is urging the Government to take immediate action to introduce legislation that would make Castle Law a reality in Queensland.

“Queenslanders expect leadership,” **Andrew McColl** added. “The sheer size of this petition crosses party lines and geography. It reflects a simple principle: **Your home. Your family. Your right to defend.** The Government should move now to deliver the clarity people are asking for.”
