National service needed to improve citizenship

FamilyVoice Australia spokesman David d'Lima says Citizenship Day this year (on 17th September) should prompt government towards restoring national service.

“Compulsory military training is desperately needed as we see a rise of so-called ‘sovereign citizens’ who despise the police and reject the courts, while taking up arms against the state,” David d'Lima said.
