Defence of Human Rights	★ Opposed the Human Rights Bill 2018, which specifically excluded "killing of an unborn child" from any legal protection	★ Specifically excluded "killing of an unborn child" from any legal protection in the Human Rights Bill 2018 (Sec. 106)
