Gender on Government IDs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Party policy opposed bill that concealed gender on birth certificates and permitted near-limitless gender self-identification ★ Considering repeal of Greens-Labor bill 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Greens-Labor bill legalised concealing gender on birth certificates and permitted near-limitless gender self-identification
Freedom of Speech	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Sought to amend Anti-Discrimination Act to unwind restrictions on speech about sexuality and gender, especially to protect traditional and Biblical beliefs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Opposed free-speech amendments to Anti-Discrimination Act, leaving those who espouse traditional views on sex and gender at risk from vexatious complaints
Gender and Sexuality Therapy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ No policy to criminalise evidence-based therapy for people who are confused about their sexuality or gender 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Supports restricting counselling and therapy options for people with unwanted sexual attraction or gender dysphoria
Euthanasia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Private member's VAD bill given government time for debate ★ Five lower house MPs voted in favour of euthanasia and assisted suicide. Six voted against. One abstained. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Supported a private member's bill that legalised doctor- or self-administered deadly poison ★ Eight lower house MPs voted for euthanasia. One abstained.
Sanctity of Life	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Liberal Government does not fully subsidise the cost of an abortion ★ Abortion procedures are not available in public hospitals 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Labor bill loosened restrictions on abortions of babies up to 16 weeks gestation to need only one doctor's approval ★ Labor bill also banned distressed women from hearing about pregnancy support within 150m of abortion clinic
